

6. Let's talk to Japanese high school students!

- T introduces Ss to the school that they will be talking to students from and the context of the conversation – daily life and school life in plain form. T displays images of the school, location and general school context.
- Ss revise what they have learnt so far in the unit – plain form and past tense.
- Ss view a video on self-introduction to refresh on the previous year learning so that they know what to say when introducing themselves to the Narita High School Ss.
- T provides Ss with a handout consisting of a range of introductory phrases and daily life, school life vocabulary that is deconstructed as a group and then Ss fill in their own personal answers as a tool.
- T introduces Ss to the Narita High School Ss by Skype in which they then conduct their individual conversation on their individual BYOD simultaneously whilst the T walks around and listens to all Ss.
- Ss write a parental postcard home discussing the learning that took place.
