Example Assessment



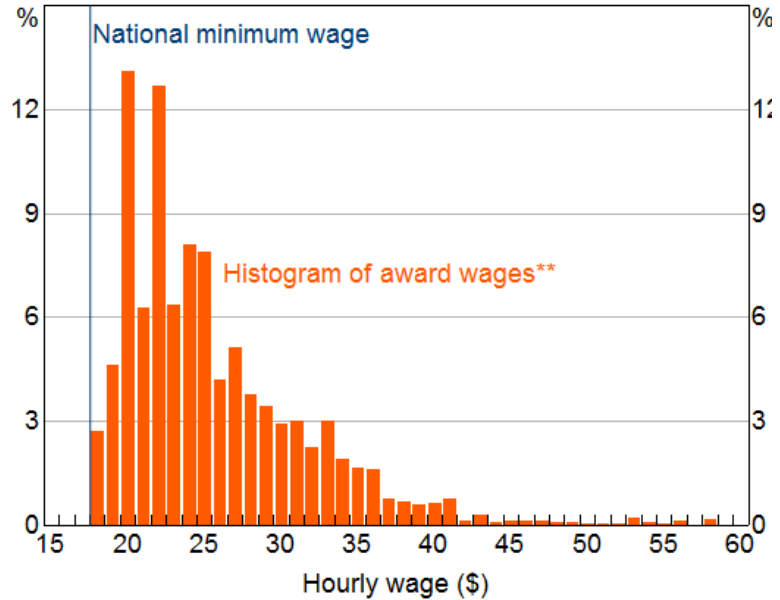
Overview

- Retail Industry employs approximately 1,284,700 people.
- 10.1 per cent of the total workforce in Australia.
- Employment increase of 3.6 per cent in five years.
- The median age for workers in this industry is 32 years.
- The median weekly earnings are \$700 per week.

Retail Industry Growth

- Employment increase of 3.6 percent in five years.
- Expected to grow 3.7 percent by 2023
- Wages grew 3.5 percent as of July 1st 2018



Employment Conditions

- Employees can opt in to Retail and Fast Food Workers Union.
- Part-time employees obtain sick leave and paid time off.
- Flexible hours and no experience needed to commence
- Full time is 38 hours a week
- Average entry pay is \$19.32 per hour for an adult
- Pay increases with role advancement



Entry Level Position Duties



Depending on the type of store you work at

- Serving customers on the floor
- Working at the cash register
- Cooking fast food
- Cleaning the store
- Merchandising



Training and Education Requirements

- Entry level positions do not require training
- Retail often provides Certificates or apprenticeships to gain knowledge
- EB Games provides the opportunity for staff to earn a Certificate III and Certificate IV in Retail Management.

- Retail is so diverse that it links into many other industry occupations
- Skills are transferable.
- Front facing customer service and developing conversational skills.
